## First Run of UTU Swiss


This is a walkthrough of the first time you run UTU Swiss after it has been installed on your machine. Where necessary links are provided to more detailed User Guides.


The End User Licence Agreement is displayed next




Once you have read the EULA press on the Close button

#### **New Database**


Next the New Database screen is displayed.



As this is the first time the software has run rather than creating a new empty database, we will create the Demo database to allow you to look at all the functionality with completed and part played tournaments. This will allow you to play with the system prior to running your first tournament.




Click on OK to create the demo database. Once the database has been created it will show a confirmation dialogue.

## **Update History**

Once the database has been created, the Update History will be displayed.




Click on Close to continue.

This will be displayed in the future, the first time it is run after an update has been applied to UTU Swiss.


### **Select Tournament**

The Select Tournament dialogue will be automatically displayed to allow you to view/update one of the tournaments.



For the purposes of this guide I have selected the 2005 Major tournament. The tournament will be opened, but before you can view/update the tournament, you will be prompted to register UTU Swiss.


### Registration

#### **Tournament**


The tournament screen displays the players for the tournament and the pairings/results for the tournament.






I have entered a mixture of White Win, Draw and Black Wins for these results
