The Player Tournament details are for this player for this tournament. Personal and Local details are taken from the master record of the player and if updated it will also update the master record of the player on the master list. ECF details are taken from the ECF Grading list, if the ECF Code has been entered on the player. FIDE details are taken from the FIDE Rating list, if the FIDE No has been entered on the player.

If creating a new player in a tournament then:

- If the ECF Grading List has been loaded, then the ECF Code or FIDE No can be entered and the details from the ECF Grading list will be used to populate the basic details for the player.
- If the ECF Membership list has been loaded, then the ECF Code or ECF Membership No can be entered and the details from the ECF Membership list will be used to populate the basic details for the player.
- If the FIDE Rating list has been loaded, then the FIDE No can be entered and the details from the FIDE Rating list will be used to populate the basic details for the player.

Once a new player has been created this dialogue screen will be redisplayed so that you can easily create another new player. If you don't need to create another new player, just press cancel.

Player Tournament Details

Pin

This is the PIN (identification number for the player in this tournament section).

The Pin can be entered as AAAB, where AAA is a number between 1 and 999 and B is any letter (a to z). No two players can have the same PIN.

Withdrawn

If this is checked, a player is marked as withdrawn and will not be included in any future automatic pairings.

Age Group for Tournament

This is the age group for the player based on their date of birth (if known), the date of the tournament and the grading federation for the tournament section.

Tournament Rating

This is the derived rating for this player in this tournament section. It is based on the Rating federation, the Time Control for the tournament section and the players grades and ratings (ECF, FIDE and Local).

ECF Club

It is required if this tournament section is submitted for ECF Grading. This is the selected club for the player for this tournament section. It can be one of the exist ECF Clubs for the player, or it can be a new ECF Club.

FIDE Nation

It is required if the tournament section is submitted for FIDE Rating.

This is the selected FIDE Nation for the player for this tournament section. It must be the same as the Nation for the player on the FIDE Rating list or selected as the required FIDE Nation for players which are not FIDE Rated.

Personal Details

These details are the same as the details which are held against the person on the Master list. Refer to the Master details document for more details on all these fields.

If the details are changed here, the details will be changed on the person on the master list as well.

Rating/Grading details

Local

These details are the same as the details which are held against the person on the Master list. Refer to the Master details document for more details on all these fields.

ECF

For the ECF Code and/or ECF Membership number entered, these are the ECF Master details from the ECF Grading list, if the list has been loaded.

FIDE

For the FIDE Number is entered, these are the FIDE Rating list details from the FIDE rating list, if the list has been loaded.

Exported Tournament
